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## Levels of ALP

Each level of ALP offers progressively more advanced objectives. Each applicant is assessed individually to determine his/her most appropriate placement.

**BASE CAMP:** Introductory level offers wilderness technical skills instruction, basic leadership development opportunities, and year-round events to foster cohort relationships. *No prerequisite.*

**VISTA:** Intermediate level encourages group assessment and inclusion awareness, technical skills proficiency, and improved communication and leadership abilities through year-round trainings. *Prerequisite is ALP base Camp or similar experience.*

**SUMMIT:** Advanced level embraces servant leadership ethics, WI trip assisting and Base Camp and Vista mentorship during events throughout the year. *Prerequisite is ALP Vista or similar experience.*
